What does the Word of God teach about trust and reliance to accomplish anything in life?

Read the following passages: Ps. 127:1-2; Prov 3:5-8; Daniel 4:4-5, 24-25, 33-37; John 15:5-6. What did God speak to you about the condition of your heart? Are you leaning on God or on your own understanding?

Read Joshua 1:7-8. Why was it important for Joshua as a leader of this nation to follow the law of Moses and to keep this law on his lips? What was contained in the Law of Moses?

Why is it important for you to continuously immerse yourself in God's word, and to stay firm in the path of God's commands?

Share with your group what God has been speaking to you recently through his word and how you are obeying what God is speaking to you through it.

Pray that God allows you to have divine encounters during this week so you can share the gospel with others.
