Main passage: Luke 12:13-21 Other references: 1 Timothy 6:6-19, John 18:33-37 Do you live a life of contentment?
Have your personal goals distracted you from focusing on storing treasures in heaven?
Read Luke 12:13-21. How was the man in this parable being consumed by his earthly goals? Can you see yourself reflected in his behavior?
How does 1 Timothy 6:6-10 define contentment ? What part of these verses do you find most convicting? Explain.
Read 1 Timothy 6:11-16. What is the relationship between our "good confession" and living a life of contentment?
Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. What is the warning and the commandment Paul gave Timothy about wealth?
Do you tithe? How does your response reflect whether you are rich toward God or not?

When was the last time you were generous toward those in need around you?

Read 1 Timothy 6:9-16 and John 18:33-37. What was the good confession that Paul was alluding to Timothy about? How does this confession connect with Paul's warning against greed and harmful desires?
Are you rich toward God? If you said no, how can your Discipleship Group hold you accountable to change the focus of your life?
Which do you do more, look forward for the day you accomplish a personal goal or look forward to the day when you will stand face to face before God?
